## Child's Play Policies

### Attendance Policies

- We serve children ages one (1) year to twelve (12) years.
- We highly recommend reservations
- We will hold onto reservations for 1 hour
- Child's Play does not care for more than 40 children at one time
- We follow a ratio of 1 adult to 10 children when all children are over 2 years. Our ratio changes to 1 adult to 8 children when there is a 1 year old in our care.
- Child's Play may not care for any one child for more than seven (7) hours per day, up to fourteen (14) hours per week during regular business hours (Monday-Friday 8am-6pm).
- Care may be provided for no more than a total of twenty (20) hours for an individual child per week (Weeknights and Saturdays)
- When signing in your child, please put an estimated time of pickup. If no one comes for the child an hour past the estimated time, we will attempt to contact you. Please call and update us if it will be later than the estimated time.
- There is a \$1 per minute fee for children left past closing time
- There is an extra \$10 per hour charge if you fail to pick up before the 7 hour time limit
- Any guardian appearing intoxicated during pickup will be asked to provide another driver before the child is released or may have local authorities contacted.

### Health and Wellness Policies

- Children must be fever-free and symptom free for 24 hours before coming to Child's Play
- Children with symptoms of communicable diseases may not attend Child's Play
- If your family has been near someone with COVID-19, please do not attend Child's Play for fourteen days after exposure.
- Child's Play staff will not administer medication without the parent's written request. All medications will be stored outside of the play area. We will not administer diaper creams or lotions.
- Children may take a nap if they wish, but will not be required to nap
- We view physical activity as a positive experience, and it is never used negatively or to control behavior.
- Children must be 3 years of age to play in the bouncy house.
- This facility and the entrance is tobacco-free.
- Diapers and wipes are to be provided by the guardian at drop off. If necessary, diapers and wipes will be supplemented at a cost.

## Behavioral Policies

- Please do not bring toys from home. We have plenty of toys for all age ranges to entertain themselves.
- We are not responsible for lost property.
- We strive to be positive in working with challenging behaviors. We strive to work through all conflicts using a variety of methods depending on the age of the child. Our main method can be broken down to
  1. Identifying the issue
  2. Facilitate resolving the conflict
  3. Redirect as needed
- In the event that a child is having difficult time with their behavior, it may necessitate a time-out (up to 1 minute per year of age after the age of 3)
- If a child bites or hits, we will attempt to resolve the situation and inform all of the parents involved before or during pickup in a way that maintains the privacy of the children involved.
- If a child's behavior necessitates the removal from our care, we will contact the parent and inform them that their child needs to be picked up.

## Meal Policies

- We offer meals, snacks, and drinks for purchase. Children may also bring food from home. At drop-off please specify whether your child has food from home or can choose from our offerings.
- Please ensure that food brought from home is labeled with the child's name
- We will provide an adequate amount of time for meal consumption and ensure proper portion sizes for each meal.
- Staff will be sensitive towards breastfeeding mothers. If you are a breastfeeding mother, please inform our staff of how to best accommodate you and your child.
- Food shall never be used as a reward for children, and eating opportunities will be used to promote a positive attitude towards food.
